### **Introduction and discussion on proposed water rate structure for 2018**

A water rate/usage analysis created with past use history shows that in order to manage and maintain our water service sectors and obligations that revenue generated would need to be increased to meet demand. A proposed rate structure for 2018 minimizes increase to customer use and meets demand for bare necessities of operation.

In this proposal, the SMR will be invoiced for water usage, based on the best possible data available of usage, to off-set member costs and promote best water practices at the resort.

### **Open discussion to the public**

It was unanimously agreed by all in attendance that an increase was essential to maintain our capabilities of service and management.

Ed Collins: Review in the positive on the job the district is doing and appreciate all that we do to make this system and its operation viable.

Monte Pugmire: Concerned over billing the resort for water used by the resort.

Charlie Riddle: Understood the need, advised the district to make sure our revenue needs were met.

Member #1: Concerned about upper mountain water needs and future service plans for the upper mountain area.

Gene Nielson: Concerned about upper mountain water needs and future service plans for the

upper mountain areas.

It was suggested that we increase each member's rate by three (3) dollars for a capital improvement fund for future water needs use.

**Information Garnered**

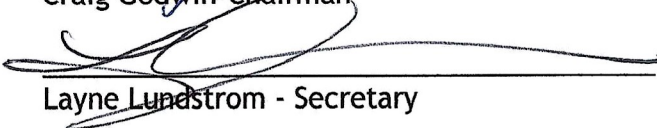
